After the installation finishes the agent won't already be running so proceed to the Start Menu and scroll to the Barracuda Folder then choose the SSL VPN Agent.

In Windows 8 and 10 you can just type "SSL" into the start menu and it will come up.



Click the "hidden icons" carrot on the taskbar next to the clock and **Right-Click** the white key then choose "login".





Clicking "login" will launch the VPN site in your default web browser then you login with the same credentials you login to your PC in the office with.
